Introduction to Surveying (SURV 1000) by NSCC

Good news! The *Introduction to Surveying* program is ready to be up and running in the new year. This course provides a broad overview of the surveying industry in Canada. Students develop fundamental skills needed for entry-level work in industry. Topics include functions of the survey industry, professional use of equipment, the role of basic survey math, completion of common survey tasks, safety, and professionalism.

The course is intended to be offered to students across the country. Details of the course are noted below:

- Enrollment is open now
- The course is scheduled to commence on January 18, 2021
- They are hoping to have a minimum of 10 students signed up for the first course
- The course is setup as a 45-hour course (if this were an in-class course, that would equate to 3 hours of class time for 15 weeks. Being online, they expect this will be more fluid)
- The course content has been developed around the expectation that students will have ~1 hour a week of employer time to devote (this is based on the survey results from our membership)
- The course cost will be \$350 per student (excluding any required textbooks or additional costs is required)
